

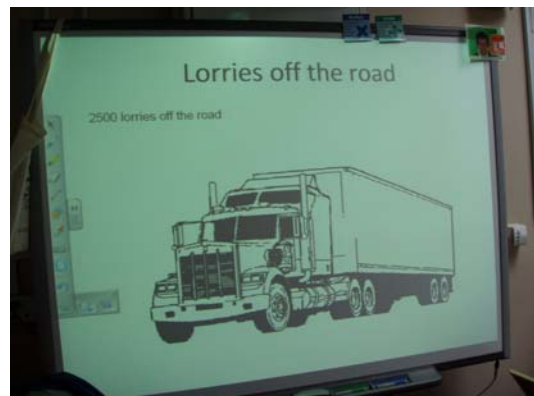
Happy Eco Easter!

Year 2 discovered;

- Reducing the size of boxes reduces the amount of cardboard and plastic used AND reduces the number of lorry journeys needed for delivery.
- All packaging can now be recycled!
- Only trees from managed forests are used to make the cardboard boxes.
