Dear Parents

Re: Swimming for Nursery Children

Nursery children will start swimming sessions in January. Sessions will be led by our qualified swimming instructor Mrs Carol Adams, and a member of staff from the Nursery will also be present.

Both Morning and Afternoon Nursery will swim on a Thursday, with the first session taking place on Thursday 11 January.

Swimming Kit

Swimming kits will need to be brought into school every week. Children will need a labelled swimming costume (no bikinis or baggy shorts please) and a labelled towel in a labelled bag. They also need a swimming hat, which can be purchased from the school office at £1.50 (cash please). If your child has a verruca, a swim sock will be required – again these are available from the school office at £1.50 each.

Please can you ensure that any jewellery such as earrings or necklaces are removed from your child before arriving at Nursery on swimming day. Your child will not be allowed to swim if such items remain.

Swimming Helpers

If you are able to volunteer as a swimming helper then please sign up via the online swimming rota which will be emailed out to all parents in due course. We require **four** female volunteers for each session. Without four parent helpers we will be unable to take the children swimming.

In order to be a swimming helper you will need to have an up to date Disclosure and Barring Service check (DBS) issued by Streetsbrook. You can obtain one of these by applying online, please ask a member of the office staff.

Swimming helpers will need to stay for the duration of the swimming session. Helpers will collect children from Nursery, escort them to the pool, help get the children undressed, into swimming costumes, swimming hats and armbands ready for their swim. They will then need to help get children dried, dressed and taken back to Nursery after their swim. Parents will also need to dry the children's hair back in the Nursery.

In order for us to group the children effectively we would be very grateful if you could complete the attached form and return it to Nursery by Monday 11 December.
