Re: Scootability Training Sessions

As mentioned in the Summer Term newsletter, we are delighted to inform you that Year 1 have been offered the opportunity to participate in some Scootability training sessions on the morning of Tuesday 8 May.

Scootability is an initiative run by Solihull MBC in response to the increase in scooter use amongst young children.

The programme will focus on safe scooter handling, scooter control and awareness of hazards.

The 45 minute training session will be delivered in a traffic free environment (the school playground) by trainers from the Safe and Active Travel team at Solihull council.

Children require a scooter and a properly fitting safety helmet to participate. Borrowing these items from another child is not an option, therefore children that do not take part will join the other class.
