Dear Mums and Dads,

We are writing to let you know that this year we are supporting the 'Wear Red Day' fundraising event on behalf of the Royal British Legion.

We think it is really important that we remember that it is 100 years since World War 1 ended. We also want to say a huge THANK YOU to a generation that sacrificed so much to shape the world that we live in today.

We would like for all children to come to school on Monday November 12 wearing an item of red clothing. We are asking that each child donates 100 pennies to represent the 100 years since World War 1 ended.

On this day, we will be having a very special assembly in which we will hold a 1 minute silence at 11.00 am. We will also be creating a 'Poppy Field' at the gated entrance into the playground should you wish to visit it. In Year 2, all children will be making a poppy from a plastic bottle. This is what they will need to do in preparation for making their poppy:

Get a 1 litre or 2 litre plastic bottle
Cut the bottom 6cm off the bottle and send into school



Children in Year 1 and Year 2 will be taking part in a range of activities thinking about who we are remembering.

In addition to the £1 donation for wearing red, poppies and a number of other items will be on sale this week. Children in Year 2 will visit classrooms to sell the items, but they will also be available from the front office. Prices will be as follows:

Poppies	Minimum of 25p donation
Snapbands/ruler	£1.00
Wristbands	50p
Reflectors	50p
Pencil Sharpeners	50p
Rubbers	50p
Pencils	50p
Ruler	50p



All monies raised will be donated to the Royal British Legion who will use the money to help families of the Armed Forces to deal with any difficulties that they are struggling with.

Although we are all very young, we think it is really important we never forget what has happened in the past.
