

Literacy

In Literacy the nursery children will continue to focus on letter sounds. They will become more confident in orally blending and segmenting letters and will begin to write some of these letters during writing activities. Children will also be writing their name using correct letter formation. During reading activities, they will look at non-fiction books and begin to understand that these provide us with 'real life' information. We will also be meeting the Oxford Reading Tree characters.

Physical Development

During PE sessions, the children will have lots of fun practising team races such as the bean bag, dressing up and hockey race. They will participate in our Nursery sports day, understanding the importance of trying their best. Children will also continue to develop fine motor control through topic-related activities based on cutting, drawing, writing and painting.

Expressive Arts and Design

During creative activities, the children will listen to music and try to keep the beat. They will listen to and create sounds, learning to identify and compare high/low and long/short sounds. The children will create models, pictures and paintings of vehicles and make observational drawings, looking closely at shape and colour. They will also use natural objects in the outdoor environment to create a collage.

Curriculum Overview for Parents

Maths

During Maths activities, the children will find totals of two groups of objects, for example there are 8 cars on the road, 2 cars on the drive...how many cars are there altogether? The children will be encouraged to record their work by writing numerals and simple number operations. They will play games using dice, and practice counting on and back from a given number. The children will enjoy developing their knowledge and language of capacity through water play and also have fun exploring 3D shapes through a variety of different games and activities.

Understanding the World

This half-term the children will look at the features of transport, identify different parts and learn how things move. They will look at how vehicles have changed over the years and how different people get around. Children will explore topic-related activities on the computer and interactive white board. At 'graduation time', the children will be encouraged to reflect back on their nursery year and talk about their favourite memories.

Communication & Language

The Nursery children will take part in topic-related discussions based on modes of transport. They will talk about their own experiences and imagination when playing in the Nursery role-play 'station'. They will be encouraged to discuss their observations when looking at how vehicles move.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

In PSED, the children will be encouraged to think of and use their own ideas during both adult led and independent activities. In preparation for starting Reception in September, they will become familiar with the main school environment – using the school toilets, looking around the Reception environment, and using the main school playground. They will also meet their new class teacher and spend some time in their new classroom.
