## Re: Nursery Visit to Wythall Transport Museum – Wednesday 11 July

As part of our theme 'Zoom, Zoom, Zoom!' we plan to take all the Nursery children to Wythall Transport Museum on Wednesday 11 July. The day will include a guided tour of the museum where children will learn about historical uses for transport from the first electric milk floats to red double decker Midland buses, as well as a ride on a miniature train.

**All Nursery children will need to arrive promptly at 8.45am** as we will be boarding the coach and departing after registration. Children should come straight into Nursery with their coats on ready to leave. We will be returning in time for a 3.15pm collection time.

Please could children dress appropriately according to the weather, we suggest they wear their school sweatshirt, but with suitable bottoms. Although much of the museum is undercover, some parts are outdoor therefore it is preferable to send them in appropriate clothing. If it is going to be a hot day, please remember to apply sun lotion to your son/daughter and ensure they have a sun hat.

We have already received your trip consent at the start of the year therefore we just ask that you log onto ParentPay and make payment of £5.98 to cover the cost of this trip. Please choose 'Nursery Transport Museum Trip' and we ask that payment is made by Friday 22 June. Unfortunately, if insufficient funds are received by this date, the trip may have to be cancelled. Please contact the school office if you are experiencing any problems with making this payment on ParentPay.

Please note that the children do **not** need to bring any money.

### 15 Hours Funded Children


For those children that access 15 hours funding, please could you provide a packed lunch for your child in a **clearly named** plastic carrier bag, not a lunchbox, with a drink in a disposable carton. This will ensure that we can throw away empty bags after lunch and not have any boxes/containers to carry and bring back. We would also ask you to avoid chocolate, chocolate puddings/biscuits etc.

In view of children attending from 8.45am-3.15pm (6 hours) on Wednesday 11 July, the session in **Nursery on Thursday 12 July will not be available**. For those children that would usually attend a Wraparound session on the Wednesday or Thursday, this has been cancelled by Childcare and will not appear on your July invoice. If you wish to book any sessions on the Thursday in view of Nursery being closed, please contact the Childcare Administrator - please note these are subject to availability.

### 30 Hours Funded Children

For those children that access 30 hours, your child will be provided with a packed lunch on this day. Children have the option of one sandwich filling (cheese, ham or tuna) as well as carrot/cucumber sticks, a piece of fruit and a slice of cake/shortbread. Please indicate on the reply slip your child's sandwich choice. Please note that any 8.45-9.15am or 2.45-3.15pm sessions on Wednesday 11 July have been cancelled by Childcare and will not appear on your July invoice. Your funded session on the Thursday to be attended as normal.
