### *Curriculum Overview for Parents*

#### *Year 2, Summer Term 2*

#### *Growing Together*

### *Personal, Social and Emotional Development*

#### **Changes**

The children will be looking at the term 'habit' and understanding that it can be hard to change a habit. They will also think of a change that they would like to make together (as a class) and try to make this change before the end of term.

### *Music*

This half term, the children will be exploring instruments, including their voices and symbols. The children will be learning to use their voices expressively and creatively by singing and speaking chants and rhymes whilst recapping on what they have learnt this year.

### *Computing*

The children will be using and applying the transferable skills they have learnt throughout the year, including Scratch, Powerpoint, Computer art and using the internet safely.

### *Religious Education*

This term we will be exploring the question 'What do signs and symbols mean in religion?' We will be looking in particular at The Cross, The Magen David and the Crescent Moon & Star.

### *History*

In History, we will be learning about British Kings and Queens including Queen Victoria, Richard III and our current Queen, Elizabeth. We will also be looking at our own history by drawing family trees. We will be researching our choice of British Monarchy, to create an interesting poster.

### *Science*

#### **Plants**

The children we be given opportunities to observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants. They will find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.

### *Maths*

In maths, children will develop their learning in relation to multiplication and division, using the appropriate symbols and will extend their understanding of fractions, including equivalence. There will be opportunities to work practically using a range of measuring instruments and to create record and interpret data in a variety of forms. The children will also enjoy focusing on using money and making their own board game.

### *Physical Development*

#### **Athletics**

This half term, we will focus on athletics. The children will develop their running, jumping, throwing and catching skills, as well as developing their co-ordination and balance. We will of course be using these skills to practise for sports' day too! We will also be concentrating on static balances, using floor work and our agility skills by chasing balls. We will be thinking about our health and fitness levels whilst exercising.

### *English*

Our English unit this half term will be based around narrative and recount and will explore the theme of 'journeys', whether real or imagined. Sessions which focus on phonics and spelling, grammar and handwriting will continue to support reading and writing across the curriculum.
